

Register Now for our Summer 2008 Learn to Skate Classes!

10 Classes for \$140! \$10 discount through May 1st!

Classes held Saturdays (May 3rd - July 26th) OR Tuesdays (May 6th - July 29th)

No classes on the following dates: May 24th, 27th & 31st, June 3rd, and July 1st & 5th

These classes are scheduled days off and therefore not included in tuition. The summer term is 10 classes over 13 weeks.



Student Benefits:

- ◆ Ten Basic 1-8, Freeskate &/or Adult classes for \$140.00.
- ◆ Ten Snowplow classes for \$110.00. Snowplow tuition is reduced as practice ice is not offered for skaters at this beginner level since the focus is on class time.
- ◆ 30 minute lesson once a week (either Tuesday **OR** Saturday).
- ◆ **Two** make-up class opportunities per semester.
- ◆ Free skate rental for class.
- ◆ Ice House Class Card with 10 free public skate sessions, *skate rental not included*. \$3 public admission after all 10 sessions are used, *skate rental not included during weekend sessions*.
- ◆ SUMMER BONUS: An extra Class Card with 10 free public sessions (skate rental not included) for all enrollments made by May 1st!
- ◆ \$0.25 soda drinks in eatery & 10% off regularly priced merchandise in the Pro Shop for student only with Class Card.
- ◆ US Figure Skating Basic Skills book with stickers, Basic Skills member patch and year patch (book and patches given once per USFS member year).
- ◆ Sports accident insurance.
- ◆ Class Card & benefits expire at end of enrolled term.
- ◆ Refunds (less \$10 administrative fee), for classes not taken, must be requested to Skating Director by week 3. Class card must be forfeited in conjunction with a refund request.

Important Information:

- ◆ Skating Director reserves the right to combine or cancel classes based on attendance levels.
- ◆ If only one student attends a class, this student will receive a 20-minute lesson (instead of 30 minutes) as this is a private lesson. At the conclusion of the 20-minute lesson, the skater may remain on the ice in their designated class space and practice on their own.
- ◆ All first time enrollees 4 and 5 years old **must** enroll for Snowplow class. All first time enrollees ages 6 and up **must** register for Basic 1. Skaters 15 and up should register for the Adult Workshop.
- ◆ Dress warmly in layers. Wear gloves or mittens and only 1 pair of *long* socks. Skates should fit snugly and be tied tightly from the toe up.
- ◆ Arrive 15 minutes early and present your class card at check-in. The Learn to Skate Class Card **must** be presented to the front desk every week in order to be admitted to classes. Additionally, a Class Card with intact make-up "punches" must be presented to the front desk to be admitted for make-up classes.
- ◆ After presenting Class Card to front desk for class or make-up, please proceed to the skate rental counter to obtain skates.
- ◆ Snowplow skaters meet OFF-ICE in front of skate rental counter for first few classes of semester.
- ◆ Practice ice (open to skaters **enrolled** in Basic 1 & higher) is unsupervised practice time for Learn to Skate participants **ONLY**. Making holes in the ice, spirals, camel spins and horseplay are not permitted.

Class Offerings:

Snowplow Sam classes are for our youngest skaters ages 4 & 5. Skaters who pass all 3 Snowplow Sam levels AND demonstrate the emotional and intellectual maturity necessary for the Youth Basic Series, may progress on to Basic 1.
