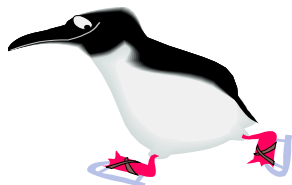

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

SNOWBALLS 1

3-6year old beginner skaters

SNOWPLOW SAM 2-3

Introduction of preliminary moves to 3-6 year old beginner skaters. Pre-requisite Snowball 1.

BASIC 1-8

Basic skating knowledge for skaters of all ages starting with 7 year olds. Basic 1 is for beginner skaters.

FREE SKATE 1-6

Figure skating classes for learning jumps, spins, and artistic moves. These classes are for skaters of all ages. Basic 8 skills are a pre-requisite for Free Skate 1.

HOCKEY 1-2

Introduction to the basics of hockey skating skills for beginner skaters.

HOCKEY 3-4 (Learn to Play Hockey)

Introduction to the basics of hockey skating skills and playing hockey. Helmet, gloves and stick required. Hockey 1-2 is a pre-requisite for this class.
