

Mice on Ice Pre-School Learn to Skate Class!



Mice on Ice is a Learn to Skate class for our youngest skaters—ages 3 to 5. The 30-minute weekly class will begin off-ice in order to help students become comfortable in skates and will then proceed to on-ice games and exercises. This is a ~~slow paced class~~ that focuses on fun while teaching skating basics. Children will not be held nor forced to participate, but will be given encouragement as they are introduced to the sport of skating. Immediately following class, participants are invited to take part in off-ice story and/or craft time in order to spend more time maneuvering in skates and socializing with skating friends! Classes meet on Fridays from 2:00-2:30 (October 5-November 30 / no class November 23rd due to Thanksgiving) OR Tuesdays from 10:00-10:30am (October 9-November 27). Tuition is just \$90 for the 8-class session with a \$10 early registration discount through October 4th.

Student Benefits:

*Eight classes for \$90 / Free skate rental for class. No class on Friday, November 23rd due to Thanksgiving

*30-minute lesson once a week with complimentary story/craft time immediately following lesson

*Ice House Class card with 8 complimentary public skate sessions—skate rental not included. \$3 public session admission after all 8 sessions are used, skate rental not included.

*\$0.25 soda drinks in eatery, & 10% off regularly priced merchandise in Ice House Pro-shop (for student only) with Class Card

*US Figure Skating Basic Skills book, member patch and year patch

*Sports Accident Insurance

*Refunds (less \$10 administrative fee), for classes not taken, must be requested to Skating Director by week 3. Class card will be forfeited at time of refund.



Important Information

*This is a very slow paced class. The goal is to introduce the most basic of skating elements while focusing on fun!

*Participants must be at least 3 years old

* Participants are offered two make-up class opportunities that must be taken by the end of the current term on the alternate Mice On Ice class day. If only one student attends a class, this student will receive a 20-minute lesson (instead of 30) as this is a private lesson

*Dress warmly in layers. Wear gloves or mittens and only one pair of socks. Skates should fit snugly and be tied from the toe up

*Please arrive 15 minutes early, present your class card at check-in and proceed to skate rental to obtain skates

*Participation in the Winter semester of Learn to Skate classes allows skaters to enroll in our annual holiday ice skating show on Sunday, December 16th. Participation in the show is optional and will require additional practice time, costume & participation fees. Some class time may be devoted to holiday show performance preparation.
