

Register Now for our Home School Winter '07 ~ Holiday Show Term ~ Learn to Skate Workshop!



The Greensboro Ice House is pleased to announce an 8-class semester of our Home School Learn to Skate Workshop beginning Friday, October 5th through Friday, November 30th, 2007 (No class November 23rd due to Thanksgiving). The 8-class semester is being offered to Home School students at the special price of \$90 which includes a 30-minute weekly group lesson, skate rental and public session practice before and after class. Additional Learn to Skate benefits are outlined below.

Student Benefits:

- ◆ Eight classes (including skate rental) for \$90.00 / \$10 pre-registration discount offered through Oct. 4th
 - ◆ 30 minute lesson once a week on Fridays from 2:30-3:00pm
- ◆ Some class time may be devoted to holiday performance routines. Participation in the show is optional and will require additional practice time, costume and participation fees. Holiday show details will be disclosed by approximately mid-term. The show will be held on Sunday, Dec. 16th
- ◆ Participants may skate free of charge before & after class on Fridays during the afternoon public session which runs from 1:45-3:30pm
 - ◆ Ice House Class Card with 8 free public skate sessions - skate rental not included. \$3 public admission after all 8 sessions are used, skate rental not included
- ◆ \$0.25 soda drinks in eatery & 10% off regularly priced merchandise in the Ice House Pro Shop for student only with Class Card
- ◆ US Figure Skating Basic Skills book with stickers, US Figure Skating Basic Skills member patch and year patch
 - ◆ Sports accident insurance

Important Information:

- ◆ Participants must be at least 6 years old.
 - ◆ Skating Director reserves the right to combine or cancel classes based on attendance levels
- ◆ Home School classes are considered "workshops" wherein several levels of skaters are combined in one class. Instructor/s rotate amongst skaters providing instruction to individuals or small groups of similarly skilled skaters, which is followed by independent work by class participants.
- ◆ If only one student attends a class, this student will receive a 20-minute lesson (instead of 30 minutes) as this is a private lesson.
- ◆ Participants are offered two make-up class opportunities that may be taken by the end of the current term on either our Saturday or Tuesday Learn to Skate class days. Prior to taking make-up classes, participants must check with Home School coaches to receive instruction with regard to which Saturday or Tuesday class would be an appropriate make-up class option.
- ◆ Dress warmly in layers, wear gloves or mittens and only 1 pair of socks. Skates should fit snugly and be tied tightly from the toe up.
 - ◆ Arrive 15 minutes early, present your class card at check-in and proceed to skate rental to obtain skates.
- ◆ Class card & benefits expire at end of enrolled term. Refunds (less \$10 administrative fee), for classes not taken, must be requested to Skating Director by week 3. Class card forfeited at time of refund.
